IWRM Objectives – Water for food security, youth involvement, empowerment & capacity building

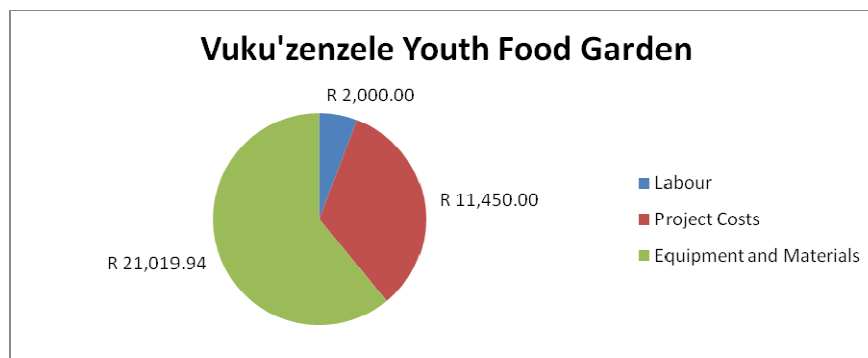


The Vuku'zenzele Youth project is located in the West Coast town of Elands Bay. The group planned to utilize land belonging to the Cederberg Municipality to plant and produce vegetables. The project never realized this goal due to lack of leadership and political interference. DWA IWRM in partnership with the Cederberg Municipality has been able to resolve much of the conflict helping the group to refocus on capacity building and further development through New Venture Creation learnership funded by the Transport SETA, Sea Harvest and DWA IWRM.

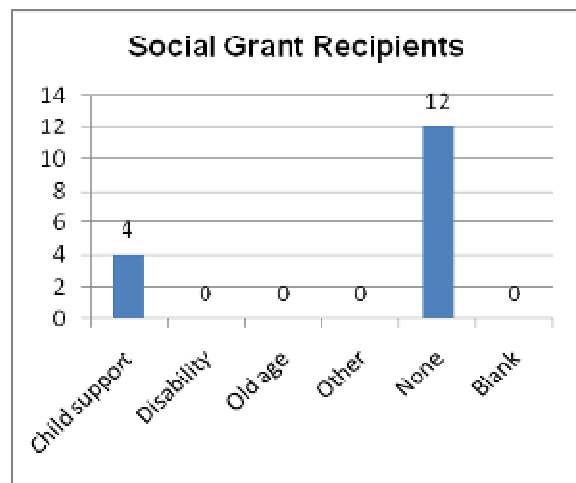
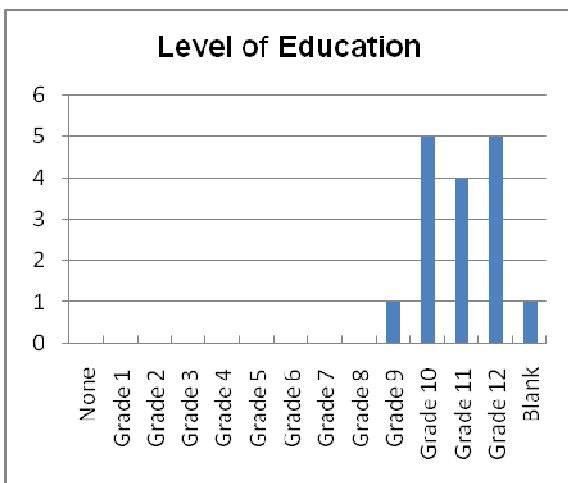
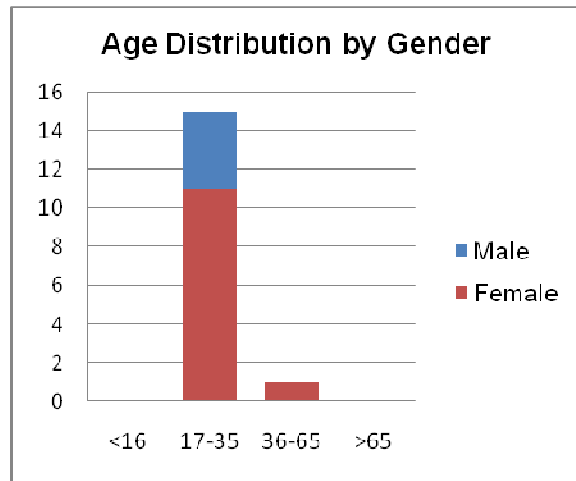
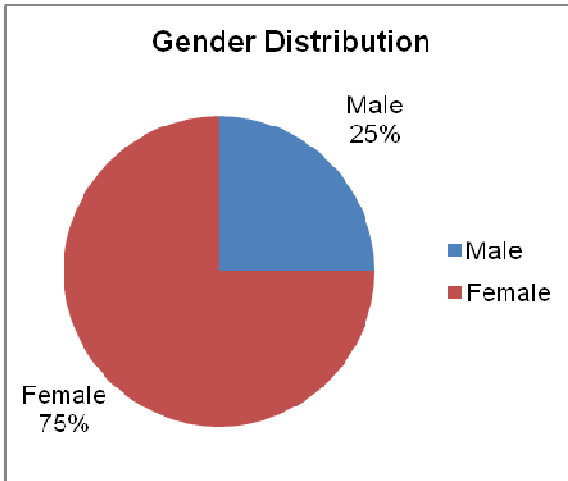
Financial Information for Vuku'zenzele Youth (VY11)

The Vuku'zenzele Youth Elandsbaai Food Garden & RWH was awarded a contract named IWRMII-OD-VY11-016 in 2008 to the value of R200,033.00. R34,469.94 was spent in the given contract period and the project closed in June 2009.

Of the budget allocated to this group, R21,019.94 was spent on materials and equipment to build the operations, R2,000.00 was allocated to wages and payments for work done on project tasks, and R11,450.00 was claimed to support the project management and administration tasks undertaken by the group.
